HORSE CAVE CITY COUNCIL

July 9, 2018

The Horse Cave City Council met in regular session Monday, July 9, 2018 at 6:00 P.M. at City Hall. Present were Mayor Randall Curry, council members Maronda Gibson, David Lindsey, Velpha Hatchett, Perry Martin and Jackie Buckingham.

Mayor Curry declared that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order.

- B. Jackie Buckingham reported that the costs to blacktop sections of Maple Av., Green St., Walthall Av., Cemetery Av., New Cut St. would be \$86,177.94. Perry Martin made a motion to accept the bid and Velpha Hatchett seconded. Motion carried 5-0.
- C. Jackie Buckingham reported that he had received an estimate for \$7,414.00 for installation of cemetery gates. After a short discussion it was decided to table the matter.



Motion was made by Perry, seconded by Hatchett, that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried 6-0 by standing vote at 6:30 PM.


