

HORSE CAVE CEMETERY REGULATIONS

Guthrie Street

Main Street

REVISED-JANUARY, 2017

Existing plants, shrubbery, raised curbs or fencing will remain, unless deemed inappropriate, dangerous, or harmful to the public by the Cemetery Supervisor

1. The certificate of interment rights conveys only the right to be interred in the interment space(s) and in no way is any real estate title conveyed to the Purchaser
2. The right of burial in any lot shall be granted only to the owner of said lot or legal heirs. The Cemetery Supervisor and/or City Clerk will verify heirs by legal documentation
3. The right of burial once granted, either by writing or by allowing a memorial bearing a person's name to be erected, cannot be revoked
4. Ownership of interment rights cannot be transferred without approval of the Cemetery Supervisor and/or City Clerk. A transfer fee will be charged for a new right of interment
5. All burials must be in approved metal or concrete vaults. Cremation boxes or urns are acceptable
6. One interment OR one interment and one cremation interment OR two cremation interments are allowed per single lot
7. Mausoleums require one 'extra' lot width (single mausoleum requires two side by side lots, double width/three, etc)
8. Planting of any kind of bush, shrub, tree, or other flora must meet approval of the Cemetery Supervisor
9. No glass containers, raised curbing or fencing are allowed
10. All footstones must be flush with the ground in order to facilitate mowing
11. Any ornaments, heirlooms, trinkets, flowers, plants, arrangements or types of boxes must be attached securely to the headstones. Those not securely attached or dislodged by wind may be discarded
12. No benches are allowed at gravesite
13. Shepherd's poles, hooks, arches and the like, must be placed next to the headstone
14. No shells, mulched or carpeted plots are allowed
15. All monument work must be of good quality marble or granite by a licensed monument company. A six inch footer must be poured for each new stone and each new stone must be 1 inch above the ground. The City does not guarantee or provide repairs for monuments
16. No littering is allowed in the cemetery
17. No parking is allowed on graves
18. No recreational riding of horses, ponies or like animals is allowed
19. Dogs and other pets must be kept on a leash and owner of animal is responsible for disposing of all waste
20. No recreational riding of mopeds, motorized scooters, motorcycles, ATV's, go-carts, or motor vehicles is allowed
21. All flowers, plants, wreaths, etc. will be removed from grave plot 7 days after day of funeral EXCEPTION: Any flowers or plants securely attached to headstone or on properly located shepherd's hooks/poles
22. The cemetery hereby disclaims responsibility of an act of God that may injure either bodily or materially any person or thing within the cemetery
23. The cemetery shall always have land designated for pauper burials
24. No pets are to be buried in the cemetery
25. No loitering
26. A copy of the regulations are to be included with every interment right purchase
