HORSE CAVE CITY COUNCIL

July 13, 2015

The Horse Cave City Council met in regular session Monday, July 13, 2015 at 6:00 P.M. at City Hall. Present were Mayor Randall Curry, council members Vickie Rogers, Maronda Gibson, Perry Martin, Jackie Buckingham and David Lindsey.
