The Horse Cave City Council met in regular session Monday, October 9, 2017 at 6:00 P.M. at City Hall. - E. The KY Highway Dept Region 4 has been contacted again about repainting the crosswalks on Main Street which were erased due to repaving
- F. The DART Foundation has donated \$15,000 to the Horse Cave Free Public Library for renovations to the library. A reception will be held on Thursday, October 12, 1:00 pm at the library.
