

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-06

**ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE WEARING OF
MASKS OR OTHER DISGUISES SO AS TO CONCEAL
IDENTITY IN PUBLIC PLACES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Horse Cave that no person while wearing a mask or disguise whereby a substantial portion of the face is hidden or covered so as to conceal the identity of the wearer shall appear in any public place within the City of Horse Cave.

For the purpose of this Ordinance, public place is any walks, alleys, streets, boulevards, avenues, lanes, roads, highways, thoroughfares, or spaces dedicated to public use or owned or maintained by a public authority; and all grounds and buildings owned, leased, or operated by the City or any City agency.

The following are exempted from the provisions of this Ordinance:

- (a) Any person under 16 years of age;
- (b) Any person using masks in theatrical productions;
- (c) Any person lawfully engaged in trades or employment or in a sporting activity where a mask or facial covering is worn for the purpose of ensuring the physical safety and physical protection of the wearer, or because of the nature of the occupation, trade or profession or sporting activity;
- (d) Any person wearing a gas mask in drills, exercises, or emergencies;
- (e) Any person concealing the face as an exercise of religion;

Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined no more than \$100 and/or imprisoned for longer than seven (7) days.
